Under the [NDIA/PSMC guidelines](#), the CER is intended to be an independent review that must be conducted by a person or organization that *has no vested interest in the EVM system; project, or contract being reviewed; . . . ; is recognized as being knowledgeable and competent in the area of EVM systems implementation or surveillance and uses the NDIA EVMS Intent Guide to evaluate EVM systems for compliance with ANSI/EIA-748*. What are the benefits to my organization?

A properly designed and implemented Earned Value Management System (EVMS) is a cornerstone to a robust and repeatable Enterprise Performance Management (EPM) System. As a major cornerstone in your EPM System's foundation, your EVMS will allow you to quickly identify whether your plans for cost, schedule, and technical performance were correct and whether these plans are actually being followed. Using an EVMS, you will be able to identify, very early in the process, the programs, projects, and operations where things are going well so you can duplicate their successes elsewhere in your organization. Or conversely, you will be able to identify where things are not going well so that immediate corrective action can be taken to prevent things from getting worse.

As follow-on to your ability to accurately measure present performance and predict future performance you will dramatically increase your probability of winning and successfully performing on Federal government contracts. As examples:

- Many Federal agencies require full compliance with a national EVM Standard if the annual cost of an Information Technology (IT) investment related to a financial system exceeds \$500 Thousand per year
- The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) requires an EVM-Lite system for all Information Technology (IT) task orders greater than \$1 Million in value and full compliance with a national EVM Standard if the task order is greater than \$10 Million.

Even if your company does not do business directly with the Federal government, a properly designed and implemented EVMS will dramatically increase the ability of your CEO and CFO to meet their fiduciary duties. Specifically, a properly designed and implemented EVMS will allow you to identify and disclose the degree of completion of your company's projects and significant risks that could distort your company's balance sheet in the future.
